Following approval of the proposed GSSP (Devuyst *et al.*, 2003) at Pengchong in southern China, by the SCCS in late 2007 and its ratification by the ICS and IUGS, task-group member François-Xavier Devuyst had been preparing the final report about the Tournaisian-Viséan boundary GSSP but the task-group chairman George Sevastopulo has taken over that role. In the November 1st 2014 - October 31st fiscal year, the task group plans to continue with preparation of the final manuscript for the project.
